COURSE DELIVERY

Introduction

• The course starts on Monday 16.3.2020 with the opening of the 2020 International Week at the KAMK School of Health, introduction to the EBP 2020 Winter School and keynote lecture.

Workshops

- International and KAMK teachers, working as teacher teams, choose an approach related to the general theme of the EBP 2020 Winter School and introduce this approach in their workshop. They plan one 2-hour workshop which they give four times, each time to a different student group.
- Students are divided into four groups, and each teacher team is assigned their own, named student group. Teachers divide their group into smaller groups (e.g. 4x4) for the student group work.
- Teachers also plan the grouping and ice-breaking activities and supervise student group works.

Course assessment: pass - fail

- Prepare a 5-minute presentation on your nurse education.

Pre-course task #3: Good morning activities

- KAMK students instruct 30-minute good morning activities on Tuesday and Wednesday morning and international students on Thursday morning.
- The objective is that students introduce their country and culture through interactive activities.

Course task #1: Group work and presentation

- Working in small groups, students reflect on what they have learnt in the workshops, relate their learning outcomes to Part 2 of the pre-course article and create a presentation using PowerPoint, poster, drama etc. to visualize their learning outcomes.
